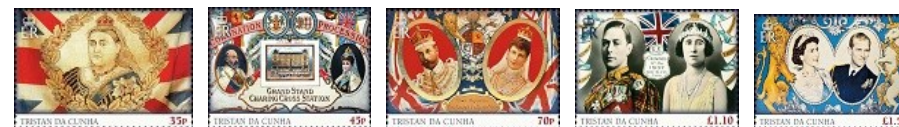

TRISTAN ALBATROSS

Diomedea dabbenena
Released: 28th January 2013

Tristan Albatross (*Diomedea dabbenena*) is a four stamp issue with values of 35p, 45p, 70p and £1.10p. This issue was produced in association with the WWF.

The Tristan Albatross is one of the three species of Albatrosses to be the most endangered. It is most commonly found living on Gough Island which has around 1,500 pairs nesting on it. The Albatross most fearful threat is long line fishing and mice. Over the last 50 years the population has decreased by 25% .

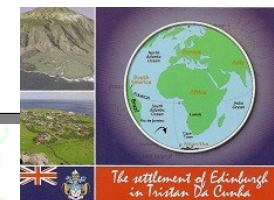
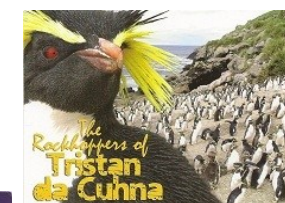
